Prayers and Prayer Pointers

Or ask someone to help you make a journey around your neighbourhood – just the few houses near you would be fine, or go on a longer trip if you'd like to take in a whole estate or community. - As you travel past each house, pray for the people who live there – just in your mind, or under your breath. Hold their situations, whether you know them or not, in your heart.

Friday 22nd November - Use your camera or smartphone to capture images that reflect your spiritual journey. Look for moments of beauty, serenity, or even challenge. Reflect on how these images relate to your prayers.
